Yarra Yering dominates first capital city wine show of the year

Victoria's Yarra Yering has scooped the pool at the country's first capital city wine show, the Royal Queensland Wine Awards (RQWA) at the Brisbane Showgrounds, winning four major trophies plus the Grand Champion title for Australia's best wine.

The 2022 Yarra Yering Underhill Red Table Wine beat almost 1400 wines from 198 Australian wineries to be named the winner of the Angelo Puglisi Grand Champion of Wine Show Trophy.

The Underhill Red Table Wine also won the sought-after Stodart Trophy for the Best Red Table Wine of Show and The Wine Guild of Australian Inc (Queensland) Best Shiraz of Show; while the Yarra Yering winery won Best Shiraz Blend Wine of Show for its New Territories 2023 wine and Best Red Blend Wine of Show for its Dry Red Wine No. 3 2023.

Yarra Yering also took home the \$12,000 fellowship which was the prize for winning the Angelo Puglisi Grand Champion of Wine Show Trophy.

Chief Judge Tom Carson said the country's best wine came from the old vines in the historic Yarra Valley estate established in 1969.

"Yarra Yering has an extremely talented viticulture and winemaking team which is at the absolute top of their game," he said.

"The Grand Champion Yarra Yering Underhill is a seriously captivating wine which features blue fruit, spice, purity and length."

Mr Carson said wines from the 2023 Pinot Noir vintage really stood out to the panel of 26 judges.

"The wines from the Pinot Noir 2023 were of an extremely high quality with entries from a diverse range of regions across Australia receiving 11 gold medals," he said.

"The Dr Bill Ryan Best Pinot Noir of Show and the \$5,000 bursary went to Tasmania's Bream Creek Vineyards for their Pinot Noir 2023.

"The wines in the 2023 Chardonnay and 2022 Shiraz classes were also of a very high standard."





Best Queensland Wine of Show was awarded to Ballandean's Twisted Gum Wines' Shiraz 2022 and the new RQWA competition for 2024 for Best Value Wine Trophies went to South Australia's Kirrihill Winery's Regional Series Clare Riesling 2023 and Western Australia's Millbrook Winery's Regional GSM 2023.

"The RQWA's introduction of the new Best Value Wine Trophy category for bottles of red or white wine that retail for less than \$25 was well received and the winners were chosen for their drinkability and ageability," he said.

The Royal Queensland Wines Awards has been running since 1876, aiming to improve, promote and provide guidance to the industry.

This year's award-winning wines will be showcased to consumers at the popular Grape Grazing by Night event at the Brisbane Showgrounds on Friday 19 July. Tickets are available at www.grapegrazingbynight.com.au
